ABOUT OUR SPEAKER FOR SESSION 7: Jenn Wagaman currently serves as the Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders Diagnostic Team coordinator at the Alaska Center for Children and Adults in Fairbanks. She began on the team as a volunteer parent navigator following the diagnosis of her daughter with an FASD. Jenn's experiences as a foster and adoptive parent and with helping other families through diagnosis inspired her to become more involved in developing resources and supports for individuals and families experiencing FASD. Jenn has written and developed a class for the University of Alaska Fairbanks on FASD offered to students across Alaska. She is also a state-certified FASD trainer, runs a caregiver support group for families caring for children with FASD, and helps develop social skills groups for youth.
