ABOUT EMERGENCY SHELTER HOMES:

- There is currently a need across the state.
- Homes must be currently licensed and have at least one year of foster care experience.
- Home should have capacity of three beds and expect placements after hours and on weekends
- Foster care rates are higher for these emergency placements.
- Youth are in your home for a few hours to up to 30 days.
