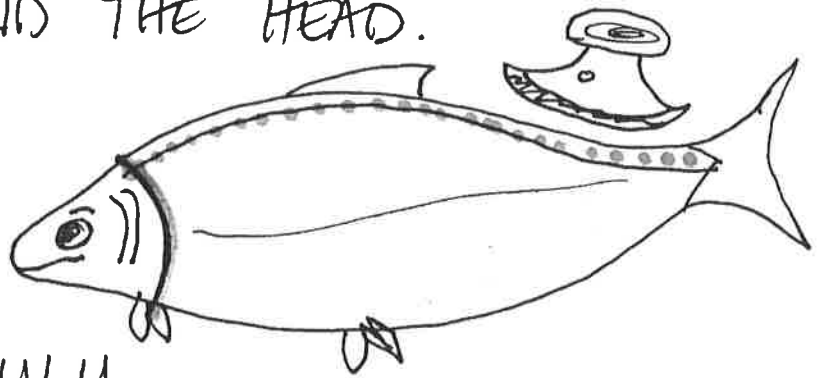
How To Fillet



A Salmon

STEP ONE: USE YOUR ULU TO CUT AROUND THE GILLS AND CUT THE MEAT (RED DOTS) CAREFULLY AROUND THE HEAD.

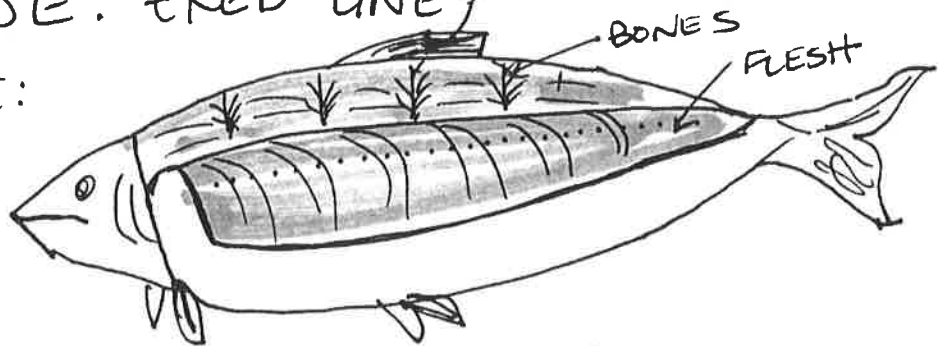
STEP TWO: → FIND THE BACK BONE AND CAREFULLY USE YOUR ULU



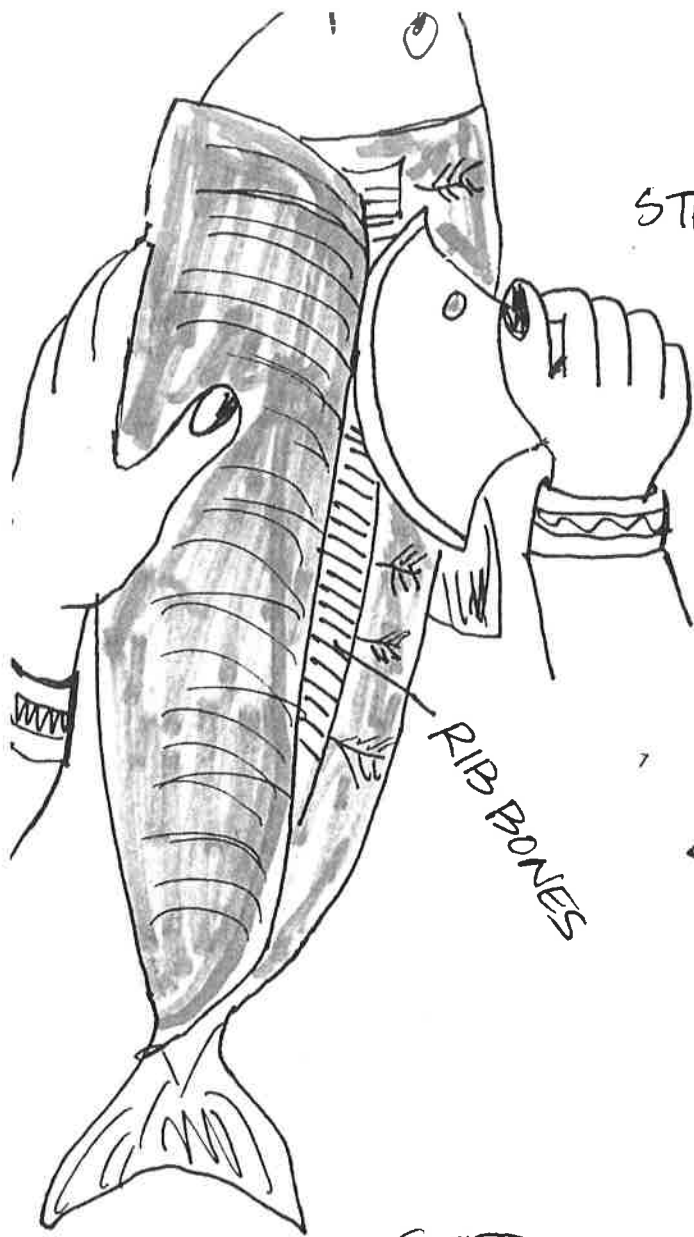
TO CUT A LONG CUT DOWN ONE SIDE OF THE BACKBONE CUTTING TO THE LITTLE BONES INSIDE. (RED LINE)

STEP THREE:

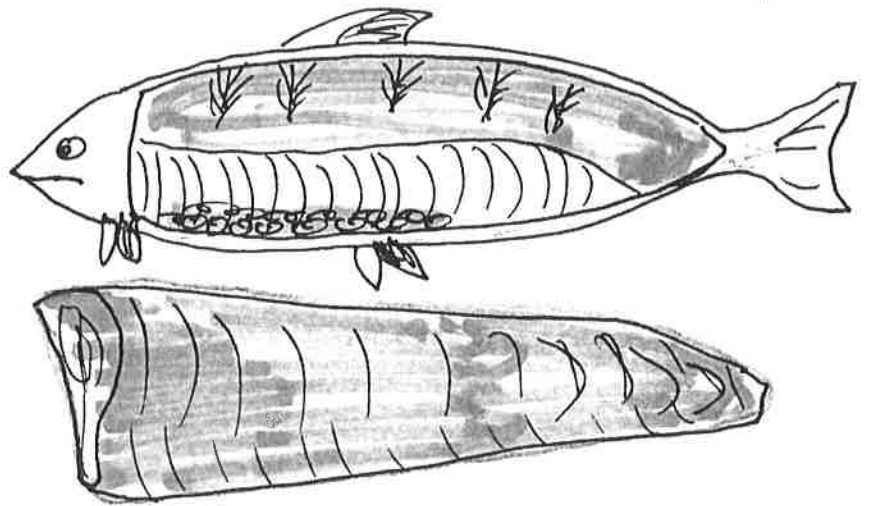
CONTINUE TO CUT NEAR THE BONES



DOWNWARD TO THE "RIB" BONES. YOU WILL HAVE TO CUT THROUGH SOME "PIN" BONES

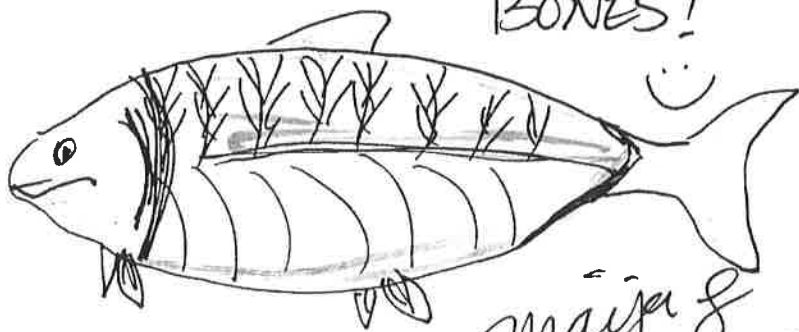


STEP 4: CONTINUE CUTTING PAST THE RIB BONES DOWN TOWARD THE STOMACH. WHEN YOU REACH THE STOMACH, CUT THE FILLET OFF.

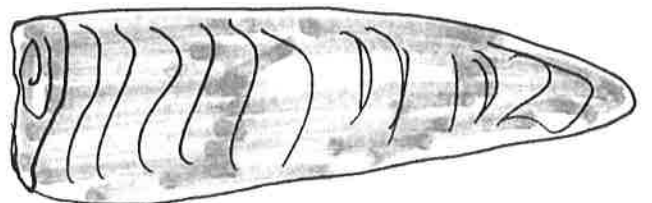
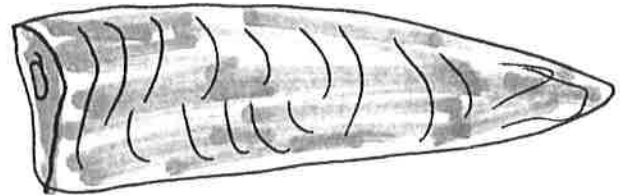


STEP FIVE:

REPEAT ON THE OTHER SIDE FOR TWO FILLETS OF FRESH SALMON! (YOU CAN KEEP THE EGGS & HEADS AS WELL. YUM!) DISCARD GUTS AND BONES!

How to make FIREWEED JELLY

8 CUPS FIREWEED BLOSSOMS

1/4 CUP FRESH SQUEEZED LEMON JUICE

8 1/2 CUPS WATER

4 ZPKETS SURE-JELL →

8 5 CUPS SUGAR PECTIN



* PICK BLOSSOMS OFF STEMS, RINSE AND PLACE IN A POT. ADD WATER AND LEMON JUICE. BRING TO A BOIL. BOIL FOR 8-10 MIN. STRAIN "FIREWEED TEA" INTO CONTAINER. DISCARD FLOWERS.

BRING FIREWEED TEA BACK TO BOIL AND ADD POWDERED PECTIN. WHILE BOILING ADD 1 CUP SUGAR AT A TIME UNTIL

ALL 8 1/2 CUPS IS ADDED. BOIL FOR 1 MIN. TURN OFF HEAT. LADLE INTO CLEAN JELLY JARS. CLOSE "FINGER TIGHT" LET SIT 24 HOURS. ENJOY!

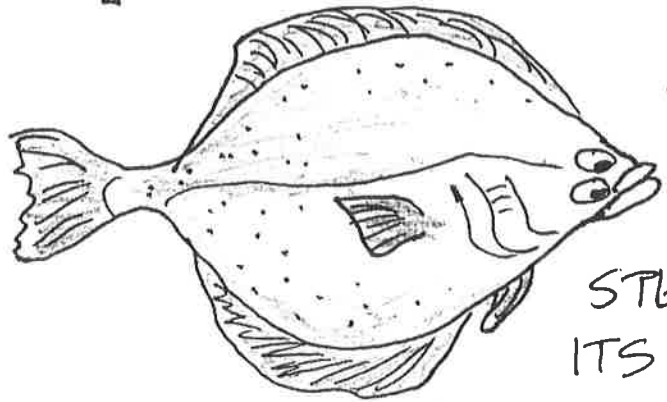

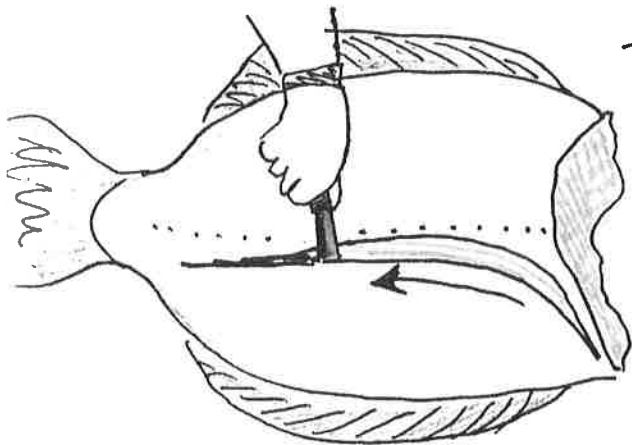


HALIBUT...

STEP ONE: REMOVE HEAD IF ITS NOT ALREADY GONE...

{this is mainly for the Coast Guard Fish that Nauiliag gives away, the head is removed!}

STEP TWO: FLIP UPSIDE DOWN, WHITE SIDE UP

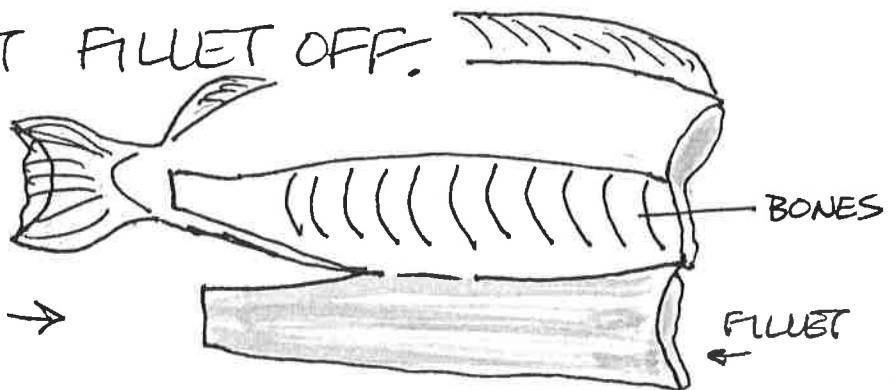


TAKE FILLET KNIFE AND CUT DOWN FROM THE HEAD FOLLOWING THE BONES IN THE MIDDLE {DOTS} ALL THE WAY TO THE TAIL. FIND

THE BACK BONE UNDER THE CUT FLESH {PINK} AND SLIDE KNIFE ALONG BACKBONE.

STEP THREE: CONTINUE FOLLOWING BACK-BONE UNTIL YOU REACH THE FIN ON THE BOTTOM AND CUT FILLET OFF.

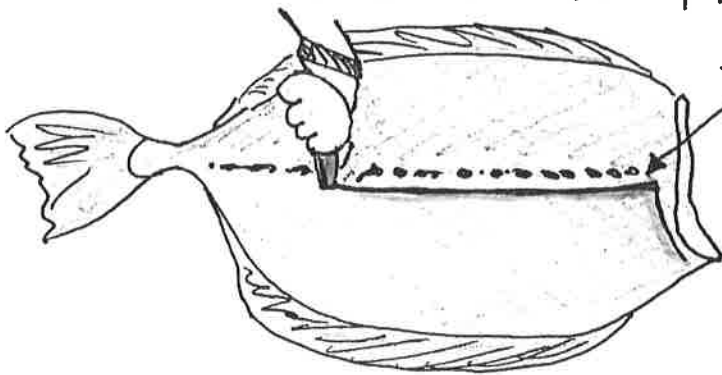
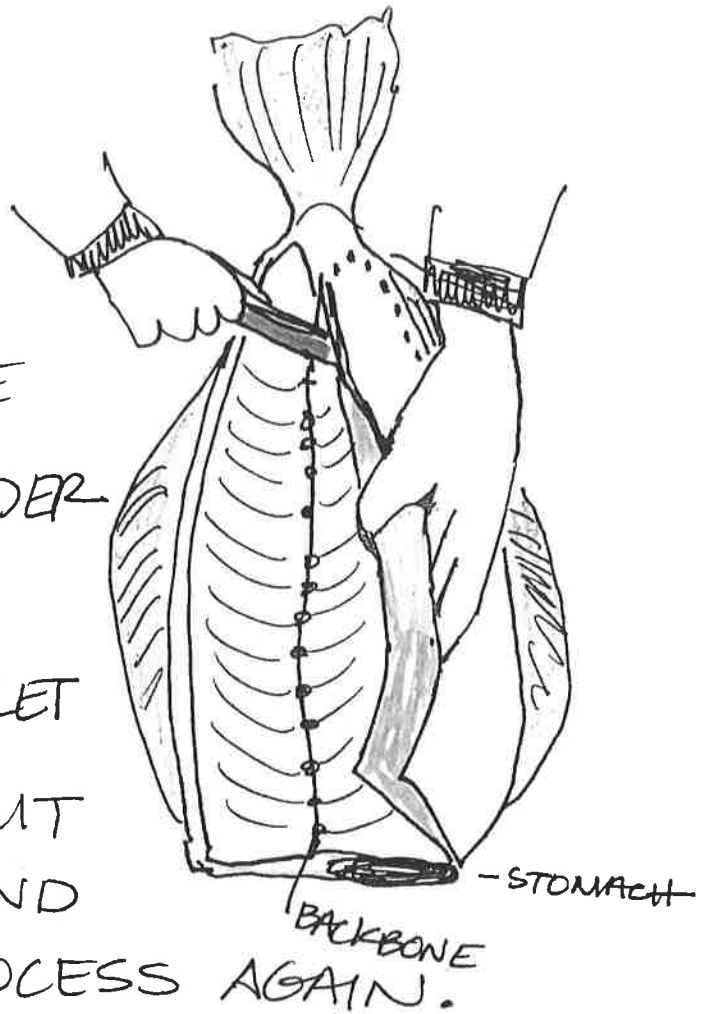

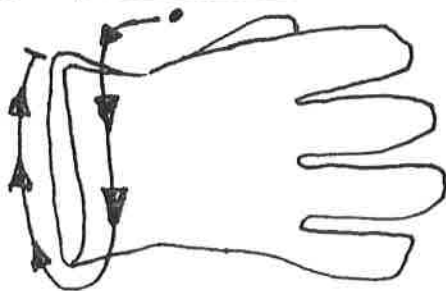
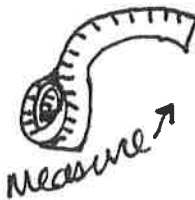


STEP 1: PURCHASE LEATHER GLOVES FROM BLACK ECK LEATHER, A1H, OR ANYWHERE YOU FIND FLEECE-LINED LEATHER GLOVES: KROGER, WALMART, ETC.

STEP 2: CUT LEATHER PIECES, AND FUR PIECES FOR BEADING and TRIM.
* FOR LEATHER FEEL FREE TO USE THESE PATTERNS, CUT 2

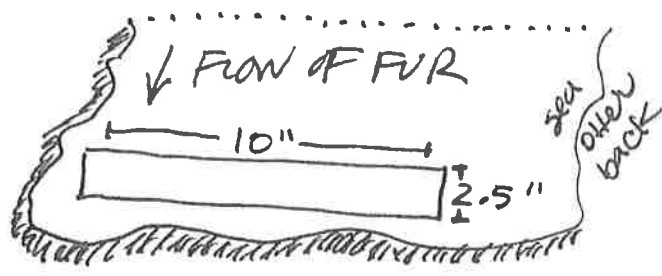

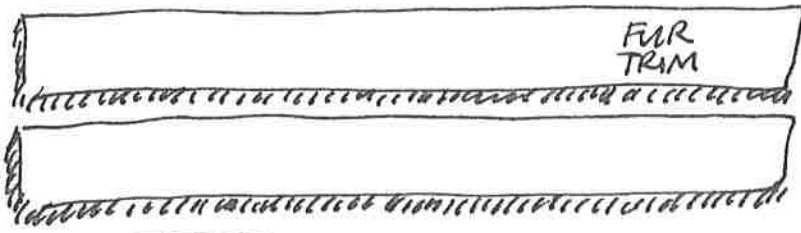
MEASURE AROUND THE BOTTOM OF GLOVE. USE THAT FOR THE LENGTH OF THE FUR.

STEP 3: CUT YOUR FUR TRIM OUT OF SEA OTTER, BEAVER OR RABBIT. MAKE SURE THE FLOW OF THE FUR IS STRAIGHT DOWN. USE THE MEASUREMENT FROM THE GLOVE, example: 10" AROUND THE BOTTOM, MEASURE 2.5" IN HEIGHT and cut. cut a



AT THIS TIME YOU SHOULD HAVE THE FOLLOWING:

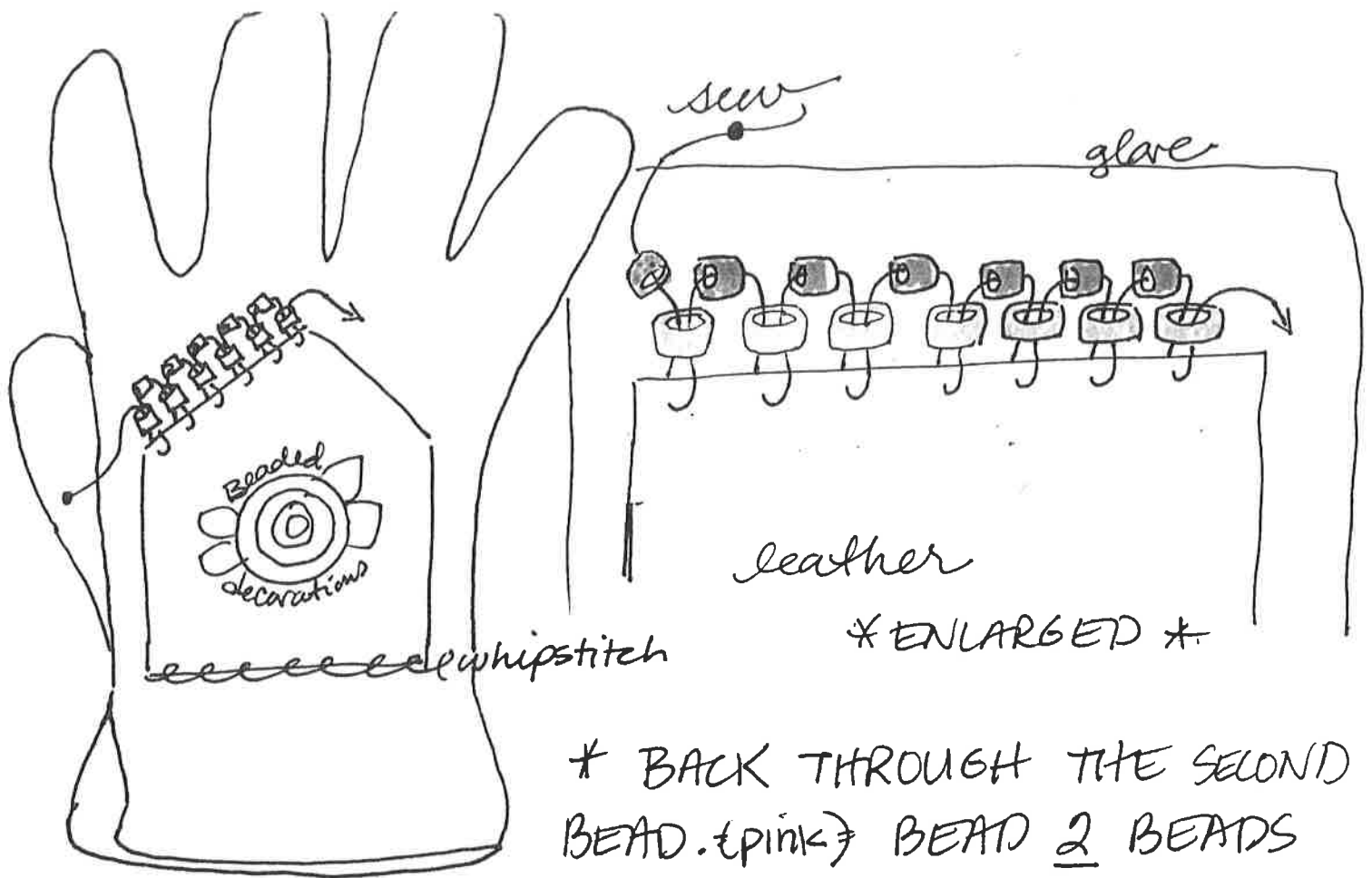
2 LEATHER PIECES, 2 FUR TRIM PIECES, 2 GLOVES.



STEP 4: BEAD YOUR LEATHER PIECES HOWEVER YOU WISH. SOMETIMES PEOPLE SELL BEADED FLOWERS YOU CAN USE, AS WELL AS BEADED GLOVE TOPS. IF YOU WANT TO LEARN, FIND SOMEONE WHO KNOWS HOW AND WATCH OR ASK THEM TO TEACH YOU. ☺

STEP 5: BEAD YOUR LEATHER ONTO THE TOPS OF THE GLOVES...

KNOT THE STRING. WHIPSTITCH THE BOTTOM. START ON EITHER SIDE BY BEADING TWO BEADS, CONTRASTING COLORS. GO THROUGH BOTH THE LEATHER and the GLOVE. COME AROUND AND BEAD →



* BACK THROUGH THE SECOND BEAD. (pink) BEAD 2 BEADS AGAIN (GREEN THEN PINK). GO THROUGH BOTH THE LEATHER AND THE GLOVE AND COME UP BACK THROUGH THE SECOND BEAD (PINK). REPEAT UNTIL YOU ARE AROUND THE ENTIRE BEADED LEATHER PIECE. REPEAT 2nd GLOVE.

STEP 6: CAREFULLY WHIPSTITCH THE FUR TO THE BOTTOM OF THE GLOVE. MAKE SURE THE FUR IS FLOWING DOWN. DO NOT SEW THE BOTTOM SIDE SLIT CLOSED. START AT THE TOP FUR and PLACE THE FUR ON THE BOTTOM OF THE LEATHER PIECE. →



WHIPSTITCH THE TOP FIRST. THEN MOVE TO THE BOTTOM AND CAREFULLY HOLD THE FUR UP, WHILE YOU WHIPSTITCH THE BOTTOM ONTO THE GLOVE AS WELL.

REMEMBER TO KEEP THE SIDE SLIT OPEN, AND

CAREFULLY SEW AROUND THAT. IF YOU WANT THE SLIT OPEN SO YOU CAN PUT THE GLOVE ON and OFF EASILY!

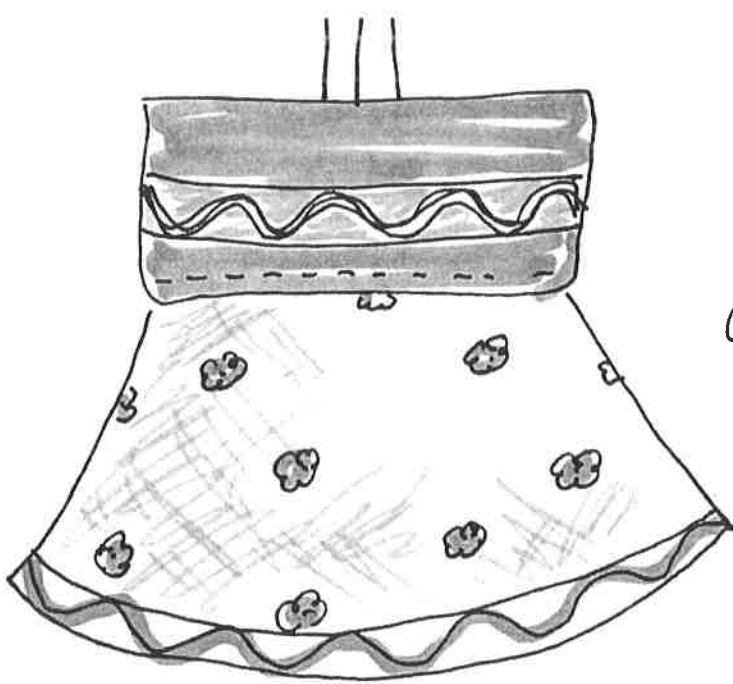
STEP 7. REPEAT ON THE OTHER SIDE.

SOME PEOPLE LIKE TO ADD ADDITIONAL FUR TO THE SIDES. IF YOU WANT TO DO THAT YOU CAN, BUT YOU DO NOT BEAD THAT SIDE, ONLY THE EXPOSED LEATHER ON TOP. (FUR ADDED RED) (BEADED TOP GREEN)

PLACE THE LINING IN THE HAT, MATCHING THE FOUR EDGES WITH THE RAW EDGES OF THE: FRONT FUR, TWO TOP FUR EAR FLAPS, AND THE TOP OF THE INSIDE FUR. *DO NOT SEW THE TOP OF THE INSIDE FUR TO THE LINING, LEAVE THAT ONE AREA OPEN! * THE "RIGHT" SIDE OF THE LINING SHOULD BE FACING THE

"RIGHT" SIDE OF THE FUR HAT. WHEN YOU SEW THE LINING, YOU SHOULD BE SEEING THE RAW EDGES AND "WRONG" SIDE OF BOTH THE LINING AND THE HAT. IT SORT OF LOOKS LIKE YOU'RE SEWING A "BALL" WITH EAR FLAPS AT THIS POINT!

STEP 9: START SEWING THE LINING IN, ONLY ON THREE SIDES.

WHIPSTITCH THE LINING MAKING SURE YOU'RE SEWING LINING TO FUR THE ENTIRE TIME.

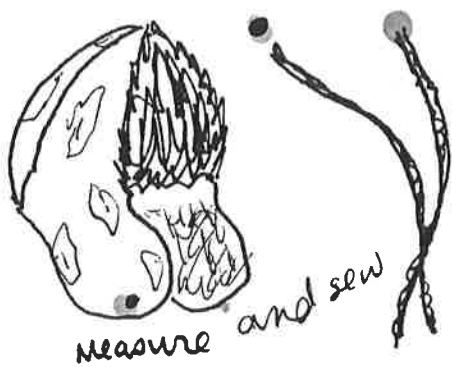


STEP 10: USING THE OPENING YOU LEFT AT THE LINING and BACK NECK FUR PIECE, FLIP THE ENTIRE HAT RIGHT SIDE OUT, CAREFUL NOT TO RIP OR PULL YOUR STITCHES. YOUR HAT SHOULD LOOK LIKE A FULLY-DONE FUR HAT NOW, WITH ONLY ONE LITTLE HOLE

AT THE BACK OF THE NECK.

STEP 11: CAREFULLY WHIPSTITCH THE NECK FUR PIECE TO THE LINING. THIS IS SIMPLY TO CLOSE THE HOLE AND KEEP THE FUR DOWN. ASIDE FROM STRINGS YOUR HAT IS DONE! **STEP 12:** MAKE

STRINGS WITH YARN AND MEASURE WHERE YOU WANT THEM TO BE. MARK ON YOUR EAR FLAP AND SEW THE STRINGS ON WITH SINEW OR DENTAL FLOSS, CAREFULL TO BE THOROUGH AND TIGHT. ONCE THE STRINGS ARE SEWN IN, YOU'RE DONE AND CAN GO HUNTING NOW!
